



The Face Cloth

Two Easy Versions



There is nothing like the feel of a soft, gentle, handmade face cloth against your skin. These make great gifts and can be used as Dish Cloths too.

MATERIALS

- Yarn: Approximately 75 yards of worsted weight cotton yarn
- Needles: Size 8 Needles
- Notions: Darning needle for weaving in ends.

GAUGE

16 - 18 Stitches across and by row for 4". For a nice drape and weave.

EASIEST VERSION

Cast on 40 stitches.

Rows 1-68: Slip 1 stitch purlwise, Knit until 1 stitch remains, Slip 1 stitch purlwise.

Bind off

A LITTLE SPICIER VERSION

Cast on 30 stitches.

Rows 1 – 5: Knit

Row 6: k3, p24, k3

Row 7: knit

Row 8: knit

Row 9: knit

Repeat rows 6 – 9, 9 times

Knit the next 3 rows.

Next row, bind off
